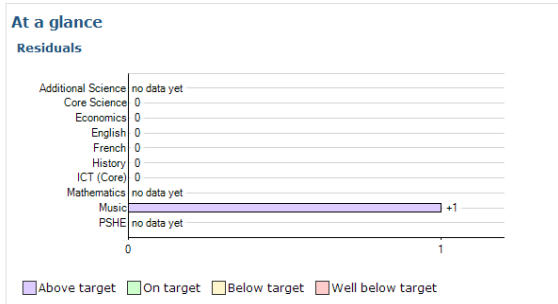


Go4Schools – Parent FAQ

- **What does the ‘At a glance’ chart tell me?**



This gives a quick summary to show if your child’s ‘Teacher Prediction’ (see below) is equal to, above or below the ‘Minimum Target’ (see below).

- **What is the Teacher Prediction?**

At KS4 and Sixth form, this is the grade that the teacher thinks your child will achieve at the end of the course based on attitude, effort, homework and progress. For KS3 it is the grade the teacher thinks your child will achieve at the end of the academic year. This grade will be reviewed each term and so may change through the year. By comparing it with the Minimum Target you can see if your child is on track to achieve the grade or not.

- **What is the Minimum Target?**

This is the minimum grade that we hope students will achieve, based on estimates which use KS2 English Reading Score and the Maths results (provided by Fischer Family Trust and other sources), and are adjusted by teachers to take into account actual progress and current performance. This is fixed at the beginning of the year and is then set for the remainder of the year.

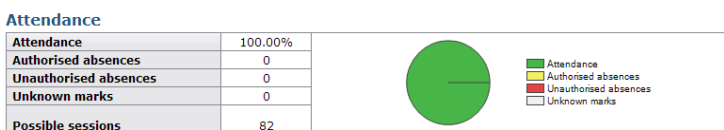

Some of these marks may contribute to the final grade, some may not – but they should all give an indication of how your child is doing in each subject. All subjects should record at least one assessment per term.

- What are the ‘attitude to learning’ grades?

Attitude to learning is	N/A	Excellent (e.g. always; pays full attention; looks for ways to improve learning; is exceptionally positive; tries his/her best)
Overall attainment for this set of assessments based on the average of all assessments		5

These are the grades that indicate your child’s attitude to learning on a scale of 1 – 5 (poor – excellent) for each subject. This will be reviewed and updated once per term for KS3 and KS4 and once every half term for sixth form. If it is low then that clearly indicates an area of improvement for your child.

- What does the ‘Attendance’ chart show me?



This is the official am and pm registration attendance figures. Details on subject lesson attendance can be seen on the student’s timetable on the right. This appears once a register is saved.
