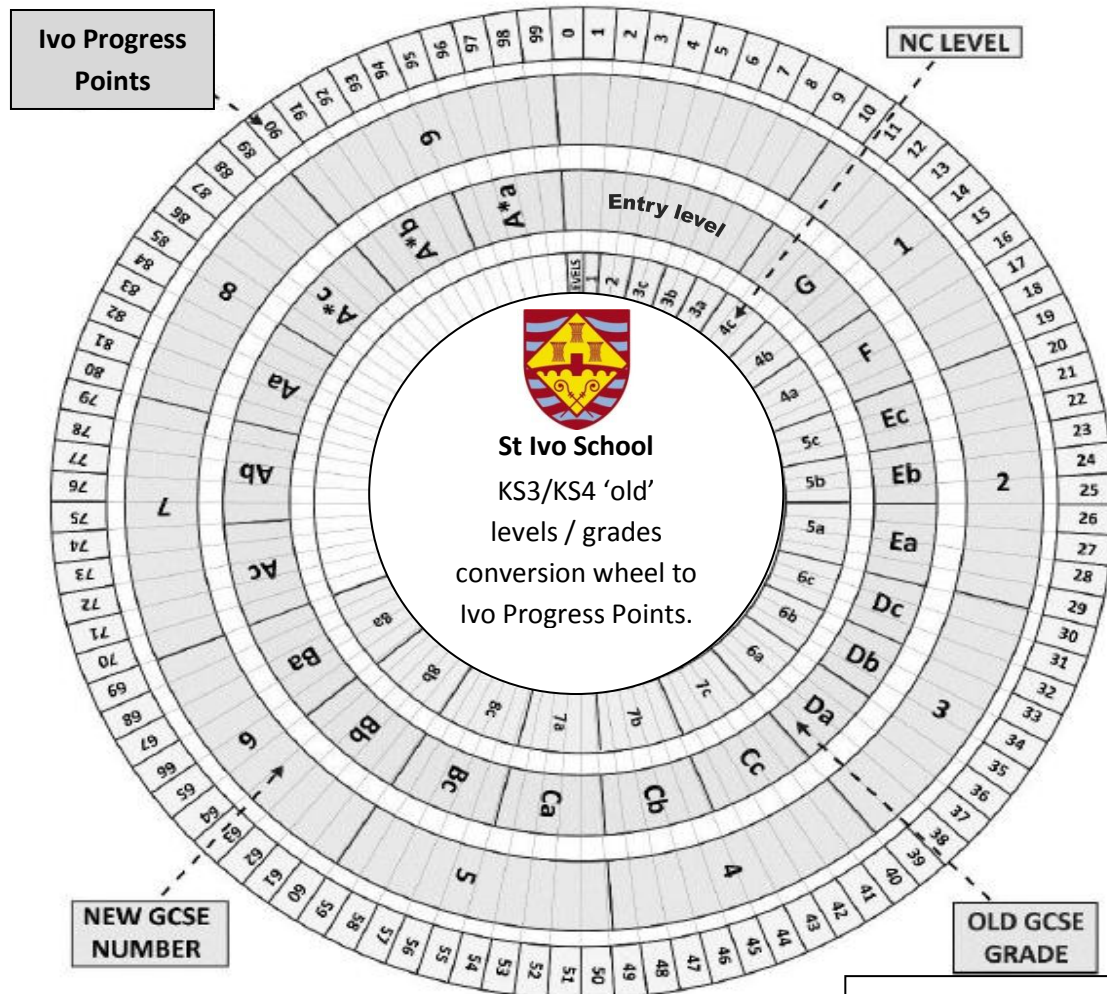




# Ivo Progress Points

## 'My Progress'



Note:  
**Da** represents a 'high' D grade,  
**Db** a 'middle' D grade and  
**Dc** a 'low' D grade.

Ivo Progress Points were used as an attempt to develop a whole school 'progress scale'

based on the new 9-1 GCSE grades.

It was used in KS3 maths, English and Science in the academic years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017.

The 'wheel' gives a very approximate equivalence between the old NC levels, new GCSE grades and IPPs. For example an old 5a (National Curriculum Level) would be roughly an 'old' GCSE high grade E,

a 'new' GCSE high grade 2 (a 2+) and an IPP between 26 and 29.

Unfortunately trying to assess to 10 levels of differentiation has proved too problematic and consequently this system will not be used from September 2017 when we hope to introduce a new and 'simpler' KS3 and KS4 system.
