Relevant previous experience as a Teaching Assistant is not essential but would be highly valued.

The work will be varied and largely involve supporting our students aged 11-16 who have specialist educational needs (both learning and behavioural difficulties). The person appointed will provide in-class support, giving assistance and support to the teacher with classroom management and behaviour techniques, with the potential for small group or one-to-one work as required. Our well established Learning Support team will provide training and support for the successful candidate.
